The Newfoundland and Labrador Teachers' Association is proud to announce that we are saving lives! We have partnered with Canadian Blood Services and joined Partners for Life – a national program for organizations that are committed to giving blood year-round. Through Partners for Life, we have pledged to donate at least 30 blood donations by the end of 2010. That's enough donations to help up to 90 hospital patients!

The summer months can be a difficult time for Canadian Blood Services. While blood donations traditionally decrease because people are away on holidays or busy with family activities, the need for blood is constant and never takes a vacation. **It is estimated that 1 in 2 Canadians can give blood. Last year, 1 in 60 actually did.** Help us meet this annual pledge by donating on behalf of our team. Every donation saves up to three lives.

### **HERE'S HOW YOU CAN HELP SAVE LIVES**

#### **1. REGISTER FOR OUR TEAM**

You can also fill out a registration form at the clinic when you donate. Once you complete this one time registration, all of your future blood donations will automatically count towards our lifesaving goal of 30 donations! Any donations that you already made in 2010 will also be counted, so please be sure to register if you already gave blood this year.

#### **2. BOOK YOUR OWN APPOINTMENT**
