

Province-Wide Vote Deadlines

Item	Date for 2018 Election
The deadline for receipt of poster information from candidates for the Office of President and Vice-President will be ten weeks prior to the election. [Guideline for Interpretation of Policy #7]	September 25, 2018
All nominations for the Office of President and Vice-President for publication in The Bulletin must be postmarked by the date which is two months prior to the election. [By-Law XII.A.(4) and Policy OP.V.1. b) iii)]	October 4, 2018
Photograph, biographical sketch and election statement of nominees for the Office of President and Vice-President for publication in The Bulletin must be postmarked by the date which is two months prior to the election. [By-Law XII.A.(4) and Policy OP.V.1. b) iii)]	October 4, 2018
Deadline for the mailing of election posters to schools is no later than five weeks prior to the election date. Guideline for Interpretation of Policy #7]	October 30, 2018
The election edition of The Bulletin will be mailed to branches at least one month prior to the date of the election. [By-Law XII.B.]	November 4, 2018
For a candidate who declares after the poster deadline date, the deadline for receiving the candidate's information for the poster will be two weeks following the receipt of the nomination papers, but not later than one month prior to the date of the election. [Guideline for Interpretation of Policy #7]	November 4, 2018
Final deadline for receipt of nominations for the Offices of President and Vice-President is 30 days before the date of the election for both offices. [By-Law XII.A.(3) and Policy OP.V.1. b) ii)]	November 4, 2018
Province-wide vote for the election of President and Vice-President will be held on the first Tuesday in December. [By-Law XV.A. and Policy OP.V.1. g) i)]	December 4, 2018
If required, the run-off ballot for the election of President and Vice-President will be held within fourteen days of the original ballot. [By-Law XII.D.(5) and Policy OP.V.1. g) ix)]	December 18, 2018
