Even though I did not remember the dates of all his teaching years, when I met him in 1978 he was principal in Petty Harbour. I believe this was his second time being assigned to this school. I believe he was there first. then went to St. Kevin's in the Gould's and again was asked to return to Petty Harbour . So, from my understanding, Ron spent little time being a teacher and vice-principal. He spent more years working as a principal. Sorry I could not be more help to you.
