

## Article I Quorum

### **CURRENT:**

- A. At the Biennial General Meeting and at Special or Emergency Meetings, a majority of the Provincial Executive and at least fifty (50) Active Members of the Association shall constitute a quorum.

### **PROPOSED:**

- A. *NOTE: In view of a continual decrease in the attendance of members at meetings over recent years, it has become necessary to review the idea of quorum. As our present By-Laws read, it **could** become necessary to cancel a duly advertised meeting due to the lack of a quorum and to advertise a re-scheduled meeting to end in the same result. To avoid such a possibility the following change is proposed.*

At the Biennial General Meetings and at Special or Emergency meetings (**either in person or virtually**), a majority of the Provincial Executive **plus the number of the Active Members who attend**, having been given at least **thirty (30) days notice**, shall constitute a quorum.
