Article I Quorum

CURRENT:

A. At the Biennial General Meeting and at Special or Emergency Meetings, a majority of the Provincial Executive and at least fifty (50) Active Members of the Association shall constitute a quorum.

PROPOSED:

A. NOTE: In view of a continual decrease in the attendance of members at meetings over recent years, it has become necessary to review the idea of quorum. As our present By-Laws read, it could become necessary to cancel a duly advertised meeting due to the lack of a quorum and to advertise a re-scheduled meeting to end in the same result. To avoid such a possibility the following change is proposed.

At the Biennial General Meetings and at Special or Emergency meetings (either in person or virtually), a majority of the Provincial Executive plus the number of the Active Members who attend, having been given at least thirty (30) days notice, shall constitute a quorum.
