In accordance with Association policy, regular communication will be provided to NLTA members by way of periodic updates on the status of the collective bargaining process. This communiqué is a follow up to the June 16, 2021 Bargaining Brief.

The date to commence negotiations for a new Labrador West Collective Agreement with an exchange of opening proposals had been scheduled for Wednesday, June 30, 2021. On Friday, June 25, government's chief negotiator, Brian Miller, informed the Association that the employer would not be available for June 30, due to unavoidable scheduling issues.

The NLTA continues to push for the commencement of negotiations and has requested a date to exchange opening proposals as soon as possible.

The Labrador West Collective Agreement expired on August 31, 2020. Pursuant to Article 3 of the Labrador West Collective Agreement, the Agreement in place remains in full force and effect until such time as a new contract is negotiated. We will keep you advised of any significant developments or progress in negotiations through subsequent Bargaining Briefs and other communications as necessary.
