This update is provided as a follow up to the last Bargaining Brief on October 7, 2022. The NLTA Negotiating Team met for training and preparation from September 27–29, inclusive, and the parties met for negotiation sessions on October 19–20, November 14–16 and December 6–8, 2022, as well as January 17-19, 2023. Additional dates have been booked for February 21-23, 2023. As per Association policy, details of both the Association and employer opening packages were provided to members following the presentation of same to Joint Council in November 2022.
