The **deadline for nominations** for the positions of NLTA President and Vice-President is **Sunday, November 4, 2018**.



**Voting will take place at your school on Tuesday, December 4, 2018**. All voting must be completed by 3:30 p.m. on voting day. Detailed voting guidelines will be supplied to your NLTA school representative the week of November 12.
