This is a wonderful opportunity to be part of an important milestone moment in a person's life – getting your driver's licence.

We know that after a full career of teaching, most retired teachers are not looking for another full-time job. Safety NL Driving Instructors have plenty of flexibility to choose the number of hours they wish to work; schedule lessons directly with students at mutually agreeable times; and choose to instruct in the classroom, in the car or both. Students enrolled in the Learn to Drive program receive 25 hours of in-class and/or online instruction along with at least 10.5 hours of in-car driving instruction. We provide you with the vehicle and the training needed to help students acquire their driver's licence.

Here's what you need to become a Safety NL Driving Instructor:

- Class 5 driver's license and a minimum 5 years driving experience
- Current Code of Conduct and Vulnerable Sector Check
- Clean Driver's Abstract (no at-fault accidents within a 7-year period)
- Complete our training program (approximately 5-6 weeks in length)
- Pass a provincial written and driving test for instructors
- Ability to evaluate and record the performance of students and clients
- A positive attitude and ability to provide in-car interventions in a safe and controlled manner
- Ability to communicate effectively with people between the ages of 16 and 75

Safety NL has been providing safety services and advocacy for over 70 years. We also provide motorcycle training, off-road vehicle safety training and occupational health and safety training. Safety NL works with stakeholders throughout the province to support community safety including the delivery of bicycle rodeos, presentations to schools, safety campaigns and other activities.
