NLTA BIENNIAL GENERAL MEETING BEING HELD IN ST. JOHN'S, APRIL 22-25, 2025

St. John's... The 2025 Biennial General Meeting of the Newfoundland and Labrador Teachers' Association (NLTA) will take place from April 22–25, 2025 at the Sheraton Hotel Newfoundland in St. John's.

Approximately 200 NLTA delegates representing teachers from across the province will gather to debate and vote on resolutions from Branches and Special Interest Councils, consider proposed by-law amendments, and address other key matters shaping the direction of the Association.

This year's BGM will mark the final Convention for Trent Langdon in his role as NLTA President, with his term concluding on July 31, 2025. The event will also feature the installation of incoming President Dale Lambe, who will officially begin his term on August 1, 2025.
